Hello!

We understand that this year, you will be able to vote in the local elections for the first time in Slade Ward.

On 6<sup>th</sup> May 2021 you will be able to vote for your County Councillor, District Councillor and 3 Town Councillors (as well as the Police and Crime Commissioner).

Stroud Slade Ward, where you live, has been represented by Green councillors since 1986! It has a Green County Councillor, Green District Councillor and a Green Town Councillor.

Green Councillors work hard for the people in their communities, keeping Stroud Green and making sure that the Council works for you. We're always looking for positive ways to make this a better place to live:

- Road Safety: getting 20 mph speed cameras installed on Bisley Old Road
- Parking: painting white lines on dangerous corners to stop people parking there
- Housing: all new housing developments to be carbon neutral
- Council housing: new council housing built at the Top of Town
- Climate: getting the council to declare a Climate Change Emergency
- Carbon neutral: leading plans for a carbon neutral District by 2030
- Renewables: encouraging the development of renewable energy projects
- Recycling: Under Green leadership Stroud has become the best for reducing waste and increasing recycling

Could you see yourself voting for the Green Party? We have a different way of doing things. We believe:

- Councillors should be independent - working for their residents, not their Party
- Big changes are needed quickly if we are going to tackle the climate crisis
- Our economy needs to change; we want a system that works for people and planet
- Our society should be more equal and value everyone equally, whoever you are and wherever you are from.

It's easy to vote! A few weeks before the election you will get a card in the post with details of your polling station. You can either vote in person or with a postal or proxy vote – recommended this time due to possible COVID risks and restrictions (and easier not to forget!)
